Have you been missing Sunday Movie Nights? This month, the *Faith and Justice Committee* will host Virtual Movie Night on Zoom. Get comfy on your own couch at home with some virtual dessert and watch a movie together with others.

## This month's movie is "The Social Dilemma"



"The documentary examines the effect that a handful of companies, including but not limited to Google, Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter have over the public; it is emphasized that a relatively small number of engineers make decisions that impact billions of people. The documentary examines the current state of social media platforms focusing more specifically on problems in the industry. Jeff Orlowski designed the film to include conversations that tackle concepts in technology such as data mining, technology addiction, machine learning, artificial intelligence, and surveillance capitalism. The film follows a cast of interviewees, most of whom have left their respective companies due to varying ethical concerns that the industry as a whole has lost its way."

Here's how it will work:

- Join the Zoom call at 6:30 pm (see link below).
- After we welcome everyone, we'll ask everyone to mute their mics and we'll start the movie.
- Running time is 1 h 35 min. After the movie, turn your mics back on for stimulating conversation.
- If you have your own Netflix account, you have the option of watching the movie yourself, either on Sunday evening or at another time, and then joining in the Zoom call for the post-movie discussion.
- The discussion should begin about 8:15 pm if you're tuning in for that part of the evening.
